



ICC Sunday School 2019 - 2020

Information Sheet

The ICC Sunday school is a program designed to help students grasp the essentials of Islam in a fun and interactive way. Students will learn about the pillars of Islam and Iman, daily du'as, Islamic morals and manners, special events, the seerah (life of Prophet Muhammad), stories of other Prophets, and a basic understanding of the Quran. Classes are divided according to the students age group and knowledge level to make this a comfortable and educational setting.

*ICC Sunday School will begin **September 8, 2019**. Please register your child(ren) before **September 1, 2019** for the reduced registration fees.*

Timings

ICC Sunday School is every Sunday (except holidays, see schedule) from 10:30 AM – 2:00 PM. Parents are required to drop off their children before 10:30 AM and pick them up from the **school section** immediately after Dhuhr prayer is completed. Do not take your children from the masjid.

Lunch

Because Sunday classes are held in the afternoon, students will also be given a short break to eat and play with each other. This gives them an opportunity to learn Islamic eating and social etiquettes, while also having fun. Parents are encouraged to provide their children with a healthy lunch.

Salaah Time and Pickup

Sunday school hours are from 10:30 AM – 2:00 PM. Dhuhr Salaah is at 1:45 PM. Students will be in the masjid prayer area from 1:30 PM – 1:55 PM. Parents are not allowed to take their children from the prayer area. Please allow the children to return to the school before taking them home.

Only parents will be allowed to pick up their children after the school. If any other relative or guardian is to pick up the children, please email sundayschool@iccambridge.com to notify the staff prior to the pickup. **Students will remain inside the school until their parent enters the building.**

If any child needs to leave from class early, please inform the teachers beforehand. In the case of emergency, you may contact the teacher or email sundayschool@iccambridge.com.

Attire

All students should be dressed in modest and masjid appropriate clothes. Girls should bring the hijab for prayer.

Subjects

1	Quran	Arabic letters, recitation, and basic memorization
2	Quran Enrichment	Understanding of relevant sections of the Quran while learning common Quranic vocabulary
3	Islamic Studies	Includes Islamic history, Pillars of Imaan, Pillars of Islam, Biographies of Prophets, and other important personalities, etc.
4	Fiqh	How to perform wudhu, salaah, hajj, fasting etc.
5	Du'as	Learn daily du'as taught to us by Prophet Muhammad (SAW) along with Islamic morals and etiquettes.

Age/Grade

ICC Sunday School only accepts students between grade 1 – grade 8. Students are divided according to their grade and knowledge level. An evaluation is done by a

teacher to determine the knowledge level of a student. Accommodations can be made at the request of parents.

Fees

*There is a **one-time** registration and textbook fee of **\$50 per child** if registration is completed in August. (increases to \$60 in September) This covers the cost of registration, textbooks and workbooks for your child(ren). **This must be given upon registration.***

Fees for 3 months must be paid together. Fees can be paid by cash, credit, or debit before or after Sunday classes or Monday to Friday 8:00 AM-4:00 PM at the ICC office. Sunday classes run from September to May. The fees are due before the start of each term. Details on the start and end of each term is below.

Fees per semester (3 months):

2 children: \$195

3 children: \$270
